


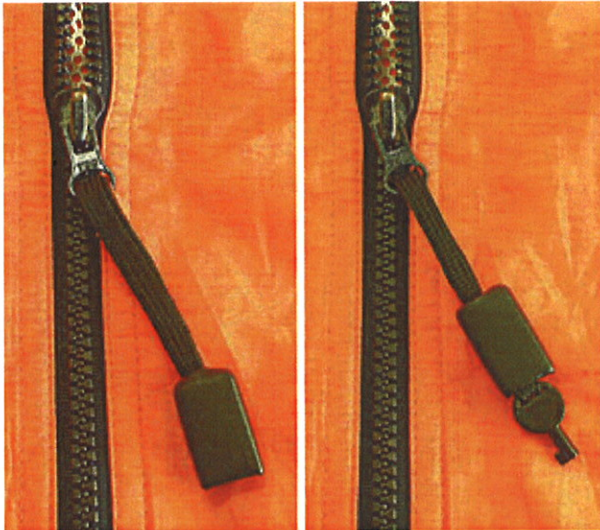

## ZIPPER-PULL HIDDEN HANDCUFF KEY



This could be one of the ultimate HIPS (Hidden-in-Plain-Sight) items - one of our covert non-metallic handcuff keys disguised as a simple zipper pull. These can be attached to any zipper on your jacket, pants, etc. The key remains completely hidden, and is simply pushed out from its housing when required in an emergency. Since the key is attached to its cord, it will not become lost even during the most demanding situations.

The zipper-pull, non-metallic handcuff key is available for **any** individual to purchase from a number of retailers.
